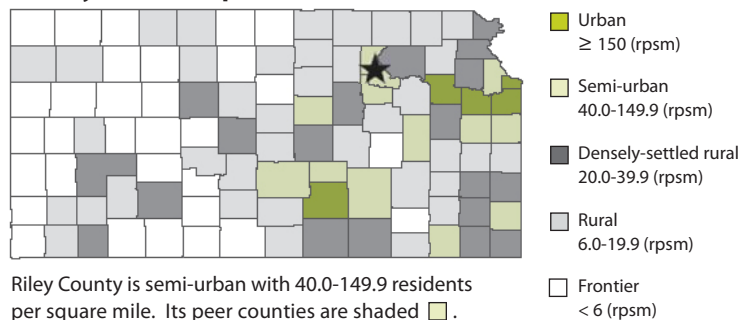

**Child Care Subsidies Note:* The Child Care Subsidy indicator reflects participation in the Kansas ChildCare Assistance Program through Social and Rehabilitation Services and does *not* include the local effort in Riley County to assist families with child care costs, Raising Riley Scholarships. This past year, Raising Riley Scholarships were provided to more than 200 children living at or below 200% of poverty, without duplicating the SRS subsidy. These scholarships are made available through Smart Start, Early Childhood Block grants and the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation. A current effort is underway to establish an endowment in order to sustain the Raising Riley Scholarships for child care.
